Prep boys basketball: City of Palms set to pick back up Monday

The quarterfinals of the State Farm City of Palms Classic, which resumes Monday at Bishop Verot, feature three nationally-ranked teams going for their first tournament title.

Elizabeth (N.J.)-St. Patrick, ranked No. 2 in the country by ESPN, already has earned its spot in the semifinals, while six teams battle Monday to join the Celtics in the final four. Alpharetta (Ga.)-Milton, the top seed, Winter Park (No. 10 in USA Today's most recent poll) and Santa Ana (Calif.)-Mater Dei are fighting to join the Celtics.

The quarterfinals features an in-state battle between Winter Park and Palm Beach Gardens-Dwyer. Dwyer, a Class 5A semifinalist last season, upset Las Vegas-Bishop Gorman, ranked sixth by ESPN, late Saturday in the City of Palms first round. Winter Park was runner-up in last year's tournament and finished third in 2008.

Also in the second round, Milton faces Norfolk (Va.) Christian and 6-foot-8 forward James McAdoo, a top five senior according to several recruiting services. McAdoo had 18 points and 10 rebounds Friday as the Ambassadors beat Miami-Dr. Krop, the No. 8 team in the country according to ESPN and USA Today.

In the final quarterfinal of the day, two time former champ Mater Dei takes on Arden (N.C.)-Christ School. Christ School, with 7-foot Duke recruit Marshall Plumlee, beat Middle Village (N.Y.)-Christ the King, ranked fourth by USA Today, in the first round. Mater Dei, which won the City of Palms title in its past two appearances in 2006 and 2008, beat Orlando Christian Prep on Saturday.

The Signature Series also debuts. The new wrinkle to the 38th annual tournament features teams not sponsored by their states' athletic associations.

In the Signature Series, Southborough (Mass.)-St. Mark's plays Bryn Athyn (Pa.)-Academy of the New Church, and Germany's Ulm-Urspring School faces High Point (N.C.)-Westchester Country Day. Urspring School is the first international program to play in the City of Palms.

Three of the top eight seeds in the field already have lost – No. 3 Christ the King, No. 7 Memphis (Tenn.)-Melrose and No. 8 Dr. Krop. Mater Dei is the only former champion in the field.
